**Purpose:**     To continue work in Terezina III with AVM and in year 1 of FBC’s 3 year commitment to the village. The focus will be discipleship of new believers, leadership training, relationship building, evangelism, and educational helps with the local school.

**Cost:**        **\$2,800-3,000 (\$200 nonrefundable deposit due by March 3)**  
**Team:**       **14 persons; Open to Adults and students 9<sup>th</sup> grade & older.**

**Team objectives:**

- Be evangelists; present the gospel in a simple and culturally relevant way.
- Be servants.
- Be disciple makers; identify potential leaders, training to evangelize, baptize, disciple new believers
- Be trainers and models; look for opportunities to train these churches in planting new churches so that through this process an indigenous church planting movement is begun.
- Be team players; work as a team and carefully follow the joint endeavors of AVM and First Baptist Church.
- Be missions strategists; be observant, keep accurate records of peoples reached, and recommend any needed changes in strategy to AVM Leadership
